Highland Lake Association Rules and Regulations

The Highland Lake Association beaches are the private property of the HLA and restricted to the exclusive use of HLA Members who hold an active Membership. This document provides HLA paid members and their guests, with guidelines with respect to the Washington and Stoddard beaches for which they have access.

****Privileges may be revoked for usage of the properties for continued abuse of these rules or regulations and no refunds will be given for the membership fees paid****

We want all members to enjoy the HLA Beaches safely. Beach Rules are designed to help keep everyone safe, comply with NH Law, and meet our insurance requirements.

These rules apply to all members. It is expected that you treat the property with respect and be neighborly:

- All trash must be removed from the beach area. Carry in/Carry out policy for all trash.
- Dogs are not allowed on the beach properties.
- No campfires
- Fireworks are NOT permitted on ANY of the HLA properties. The NH State Fire Marshal requires written landowner permission for use of fireworks. The HLA does not have insurance for fireworks on any of its properties and does not provide permission for fireworks. Please report firework usage directly to Washington Police.
- No overnight boat parking.
- Persons who are NOT paid members of the HLA (or their guests), including boats belonging to them, should be reported to the Washington Police or NH Marine Patrol for trespassing.
- Do not leave any of your personal property on the beaches after using the beaches for the day.
- No lifeguards are on duty – swimming is at your own risk.
- All children must be accompanied by an adult.
- Gates are to be always locked. Gates are unlocked for boat launching only. Hours for boat launch at the Stoddard beach are limited and are posted on the gate.
- No motorized vehicles of any type are to be parked inside the gates or on the beach areas.
- NO UNAUTHORIZED POSTINGS, DAMAGING, OR REMOVING ANY SIGNAGE ON HLA PROPERTY The beaches are maintained by the HLA:
- Periodic mowing
- Removal of dead trees
- Maintenance of the beach area and gates
- Maintenance of the picnic tables
